


Draft Neighbourhood Plan for Bow

Your views are needed!

A Neighbourhood Plan is one made by people living, working or studying in a specific neighbourhood.

It sets out policies and actions to guide future developments in that area. In Bow, over the past 5 years, work has been going on through the Neighbourhood Forum to produce a plan for the area shown in the map below.



A draft neighbourhood plan for this area has recently been completed. We need your views on the proposals, so we can be confident the plan reflects the community's wishes about future developments in Bow.

>>> What does the plan cover?

The plan's vision is step-by-step improvements led by the community, to protect and enhance a neighbourhood where everyone feels they belong.

The main themes of the plan are:

1. A thriving high street and local economy
2. Green streets that encourage walking and cycling
3. Beautiful public spaces
4. New life for our heritage and community facilities
5. High quality housing provision
6. A resilient and well-networked community infrastructure


The consultation runs for 6 weeks from Monday 15th March, and responses need to be received by midnight on Sunday 25th April.

>>> What happens next?

The plan will then be reviewed, updated and submitted to the Council, who will undertake their own consultation, before sending the plan to an Independent Examiner. If the examiner agrees all the legal requirements have been met, the plan will then be subject to a local referendum. If supported by a majority of voters, the plan will become part of the local planning framework, sitting under the Tower Hamlets Local Plan 2031.
